ENHANCED SPEED LIMIT FINE SIGNAGE ON COUNTRYSIDE BOULEVARD

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3 (b) (1) of the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions of the CountrySide Proprietary grants the Board of Directors all powers for conducting the affairs of the Proprietary; and

WHEREAS, from past sessions with Loudoun County Board of Supervisors, the CountrySide Proprietary was informed that when the above actions were completed, the enhanced speed limit fine signage would be posted and enforcement would begin on CountrySide Boulevard.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** that the CountrySide Proprietary Board of Directors is requesting that VDOT/Loudoun County approve installation of enhanced speed limit fine signage on Countryside Boulevard and begin the enforcement process as soon as possible.
