NOW, THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** that the CountrySide Proprietary Board of Directors is requesting that the Loudoun County Schools abide by their agreement and expedite the installation of the traffic light on Countryside Boulevard at the intersection Minor Road and the CountrySide Elementary School entrance driveway.
