**RESOLUTION NO. 243**

**COUNTRYSIDE BOULEVARD AND MINOR ROAD TRAFFIC LIGHT**

**WHEREAS**, Article III, Section 3 (b) (1) of the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions of the CountrySide Proprietary grants the Board of Directors all powers for conducting the affairs of the Proprietary; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of the CountrySide Proprietary wish to exercise their powers and duties in good faith with a view to the interests of the Proprietary; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a safety concern during school and non-school hours for the CountrySide pedestrians that have reason to cross CountrySide Boulevard at the intersection of Minor Road and the CountrySide Elementary School entrance driveway; and

**WHEREAS**, Loudoun County Public Schools agreed to fund the traffic light for the above mentioned intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, the Loudoun County Public Schools said that the traffic light would be installed within nine months after the opening of the school; and

**WHEREAS**, more than a year has passed and still no traffic light has been install.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it **RESOLVED** that the CountrySide Proprietary Board of Directors is requesting that the Loudoun County Schools abide by their agreement and expedite the installation of the traffic light on Countryside Boulevard at the intersection Minor Road and the CountrySide Elementary School entrance driveway.
