**“NO THROUGH TRUCK TRAFFIC” SIGNAGE ON COUNTRYSIDE BOULEVARD**

**WHEREAS**, Article III, Section 3 (b) (1) of the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions of the CountrySide Proprietary grants the Board of Directors all powers for conducting the affairs of the Proprietary; and

**WHEREAS**, CountrySide Boulevard runs through a residential area,; and

**WHEREAS**, the Algonkian Parkway interchange has now been completed, there is no need for large trucks to travel through our community via Countryside Boulevard.

**WHEREAS**, the last two boards of Loudoun County Board of Supervisors has stated that there would be no need for truck traffic through Countryside Boulevard when the Algonkian Parkway/Route 7 interchange was completed; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it **RESOLVED** that the CountrySide Proprietary Board of Directors is requesting that “No Through Truck Traffic” signs be posted and enforced on Countryside Boulevard.
