RESOLUTION NO. 252

COUNTRYSIDE BOULEVARD GUARDRAIL INSTALLATION REQUEST

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3 (b) (1) of the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions of the CountrySide Proprietary grants the Board of Directors all powers for conducting the affairs of the Proprietary; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the CountrySide Proprietary wish to exercise their powers and duties in good faith with a view to the interests of the Proprietary; and

WHEREAS, a pedestrian safety hazard exists on the Countryside Boulevard trail near the intersection of Austen Court due to the steep embankment from Countryside Boulevard to the trail below, and the lack of a protective barrier between the vehicle traffic and the pedestrians using that portion of the trail; and

WHEREAS, two vehicle accidents occurred at this location with the vehicles landing on top of the trail and creating an extreme pedestrian hazard; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** that the CountrySide Proprietary Board of Directors is requesting VDOT and/or Loudoun County to install guardrail on the north bound side of Countryside Boulevard beginning at Austen Court south for approximately 300' in order to provide a physical barrier between the vehicle traffic on CountrySide Boulevard and the pedestrian traffic using the trail.
