## **RESOLUTION NO. 251**

## COUNTRYSIDE ELEMENTARY SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT

**WHEREAS**, Article III, Section 3 (b) (1) of the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions of the CountrySide Proprietary grants the Board of Directors all powers for conducting the affairs of the Proprietary; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of the CountrySide Proprietary wish to exercise their powers and duties in good faith with a view to the interests of the Proprietary; and

**WHEREAS**, a large section of the CountrySide Elementary School sidewalk that parallels Countryside Boulevard and extends from Cromwell Road to the Countryside Boulevard entrance to the school is of aging asphalt and not new concrete like the rest of the school sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, only a portion of the aging asphalt walk was replaced with concrete, but not the rest; and

**WHEREAS**, the appearance of the sidewalk is not in harmony with all of the other school sidewalks and is very noticeable from Countryside Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the sidewalk does not conform to established Proprietary standards.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it **RESOLVED** that the CountrySide Proprietary Board of Directors is requesting that Loudoun County Schools replace the rest of aging asphalt sidewalk with concrete in order to be consistent with the material used in the other school sidewalks.
