



## **RECYCLABLES:**

The following items are the only items that should be placed in your recycling container:

- Paper: Newspaper, magazines, flattened cardboard, mixed paper, junk mail, phone books.
- Plastic: Bottles, containers, and jugs.
- Metal: Aluminum or tin cans and empty aerosol cans.

Do not use plastic bags for recyclables.

GLASS: Republic Services will pick up glass, but only intact glass will be sorted with recycling. To ensure that all of your glass gets recycled, please deposit in one of Loudoun County's purple bins, as Loudoun County made the change to have special glass collection centers.

## **SPECIAL/BULK ITEMS:**

The trash company will collect furniture and other large, non-metal household items for \$85 per item EXCLUDING APPLIANCES. THESE ITEMS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:

Rocks, concrete, dirt, tires, soil, sod, tree stumps, paint, motor oil, construction or landscaping debris, combustibles, toxic or hazardous waste, bio-hazardous material, flammable products or any other material excluded from the disposal site, or any applicable state or federal law, as being hazardous or toxic.

## **YARD WASTE COLLECTION:**

Yard Waste is considered a by-product of regular yard maintenance and not the debris as a result of landscaping renovation. All homes will have one weekly collection of yard waste from March 1st through December 24th. During the months of January and February, please place yard debris out with your household trash. Composting, chipping, and mulching are great ways to recycle your yard waste. Yard debris for collection must be prepared accordingly and placed at the curb for collection:

- Brush and limbs must be cut into 4-foot lengths and bundled with rope or twine and should not exceed 50 pounds.
- Paper Yard Waste Bags are to be used for grass clippings, leaves, and twigs. (Do not use ANY plastic bags or black trash bags for yard waste). Yard waste will not be collected if they are in any type of plastic bag. Residents may use their own container so long as it is clearly marked as "Yard Waste" in letters that are at least four inches tall.
- Yard waste bag limit: 10 bags per home per collection day.
- Tree stumps and tree limbs that are larger than 6 inches in diameter and 4 feet in length will not be collected. Unbundled brush will be considered a special pick up. Please call or e-mail Republic Services' Customer Service Center.

## ALLOWED

Please call Republic Services to schedule a pickup, if you would like to dispose of any of the following large items.

Furniture (including mattresses, sofas, chairs, tables)

Lawn Furniture

Microwaves

Ovens

Dishes, Pots and Pans

Basketball goals (Pole must be broken down to 4-5' to fit in collection vehicle)

Area rugs (up to 8x10)

Toys, Books, Clothing, Knick-knacks

## NOT ALLOWED

Items which are too large or heavy to be lifted safely by a two-person crew or too large to fit into the collection vehicle will NOT be picked up by Republic Services and must be disposed of by the Resident or Homeowner according to Loudoun County guidelines. Please check the Loudoun County Waste Management page on the Loudoun County website for more information. Alternately, you may contact a junk hauling company for disposal options.

The following items will NOT be picked up by Republic Services:

Construction Debris (includes drywall, cement board, shingles and insulation)  
Lumber/Wood/Pallets  
Bricks, tiles, concrete products, rocks or stones  
Kitchen cabinets, countertops, vanity, sink, toilet  
Carpeting and padding

Washer/Dryer/Dishwasher  
Refrigerator/Freezer  
A/C unit and/or other refrigeration equipment that has not had the chemical refrigerant removed by a licensed technician  
Grills  
Lawn mower

Computers  
Monitors  
TVs  
Other Electronics  
Floor model copiers and printers  
  
Hazardous household waste including paints, stain and pesticides

Tires (on or off rim)
